Order of Business:

Approval of SCOA Constitution and By-Laws. Discussion centered around language in Membership Privilege, Article III, Item C and Article V - Board of Directors.*

*To be rectified by special committee, appointed by President. Possible solution to change wording to: Under membership privileges: 1) Active dues paying members are entitled to one vote in conducting SCOA business; 2) Are eligible to hold office. i.e. President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and Member Representative; 3) Respective Sports Trainers represent the Board of Directors. (Article III, Item C)

Elected Mike Brown as Vice-President.

*Board of Directors: A person who serves as a respective sport trainer shall be eligible to serve on the Board of Directors for one year. They shall be a dues paying member, in good standing. The President shall preside over the Board of Directors, assisted by the Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer.

Approved unanimously the election of Tim Rizor president and Linda Hoover treasurer to serve until 2020. Noted, the election of Secretary, Vice-President and Member Representative will be conducted at General Meeting 2019.

Approved a Membership Meeting to take place Sunday, January 20, 2019 at Full Blast, time to be determined. Noted: call for an annual meeting to be scheduled second Sunday in June (checked, there are no conflicting Father's Day through 2022).

Approved SCOA trainers (Board of Directors): Tim Rizor, softball; Dave Eubank, basketball - girls and boys; Candy Whitney, volleyball; Pete Zapata, wrestling; Mark Whitney, baseball; Mike Brown, football.'
